The Seminar

The afternoon will begin with an introductory look at the growth of apparently intangible medical conditions such as pain syndromes, fibromyalgia and reflex sympathetic dystrophy and how they have come to feature in 21st century personal injury litigation.

Thereafter the substantial part of the afternoon will be a two part "Question Time" session involving a panel of experts, who will debate the issues facing those who deal with personal injury claims. The first session will address the issue of pain syndromes and the second, the ever popular topic of malingering and exaggerated claims.

Chaired by a Circuit Judge the panel will comprise lawyers, medical experts and a surveillance expert. The seminar is designed particularly for insurers, adjusters and public sector claims and risk officers.
